PARKS, EQUESTRIAN AND COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMISSION: All terms expire 3/31/2027

The duties of the Parks, Recreation, Youth Services And Senior Services Trails And Equestrian Commission include: To review and make recommendations to the Planning Commission concerning tentative maps with regard to their relationship to the City's Open Space, and Recreation Plans as identified in the Conservation and Open Space, and Parks and Recreation Elements of the General Plan of the City; to study and make recommendations to the City Council or Planning Commission on proposed amendments to the Conservation and Open Space, and Parks and Recreation Element of the City's General Plan; to review and make recommendations to the City Council on preservation and/or acquiring additional open space, including identifying areas to be acquired and funding strategies for acquisition; to make recommendations to the City Council on strategies for how future planning for land use and infrastructure should be accomplished, including funding strategies for future planning and environmental work affecting open space in the City; to study and make recommendations to the City Council on the management of the City's open space and ways to ensure long-term financial return to maintain and enhance the City's open space; to review and make recommendations to the Planning Commission concerning tentative maps with regard to their relationship to the City's Parks Programs; to review and make recommendations to the Planning Commission on capital improvement plans for parks which are developed to implement the Parks and Recreation Element of the City's General Plan; to study and make recommendations to the Planning Commission on proposed design standards for private and public parks; to study and make recommendations to the Community Services Department on existing and proposed recreational programs and services for the City's residents, including youth and senior citizens; to undertake such other duties as may be assigned by the City Council; The Parks, Recreation, Senior and Youth Services Commission shall consist of a total of seven (7) members, one (1) of the members is to be an Advisor from the Youth Advisory Board. Members must be registered voters in the City.

PLANNING COMMISSION: All terms expire 3/31/2027

Duties of the Planning Commission include: study and make recommendations to the City Council on amendments to the City's General Plan; develop and make recommendations to the City Council on specific plans designed to implement portions of the City's General Plan; review the City's Capital Improvement Program for consistency with the City's General Plan and forward recommendations to the City Council; make recommendations to the City Council to effectuate changes to the land use provisions set forth in Title 9 of this Code, consistent with provisions of the General Plan; approve, deny, or approve with modifications or conditions, development proposals, or parts thereof, in accordance with the land use provisions set forth in Title 9 of this Code; appoint members of the Planning Commission to serve on the Design Review Committee to review and make recommendations to the Planning Commission on development proposals processed in accordance with Title 9, Chapter 2, Article 2, Section 9-2.313; and, appoint members of the Planning Commission to serve on the Transportation Committee to review and make recommendations to the Planning Commission on matters related to projects that are designed to implement a multi-modal transportation system, State planning programs that are transportation-related, site development plans and tentative maps with regard to impacts to the City's circulation system, and on matters related to public transportation, traffic regulations and standards for parking, vehicular and public safety. The Planning Commission appoints one Planning Commissioner to serve on the Design Review Committee with one Planning Commission alternate to serve in the absence of the appointed regular Design Review Committee member; and one Planning Commissioner to serve on the City's Transportation Committee with one Planning Commission alternate to serve in the absence of the appointed regular Transportation Committee member. Commission Members are required to be registered voters of the City and are required by State law to file Fair Political Practices Commission Conflict of Interest Statements upon appointment, annually, and upon leaving office.
