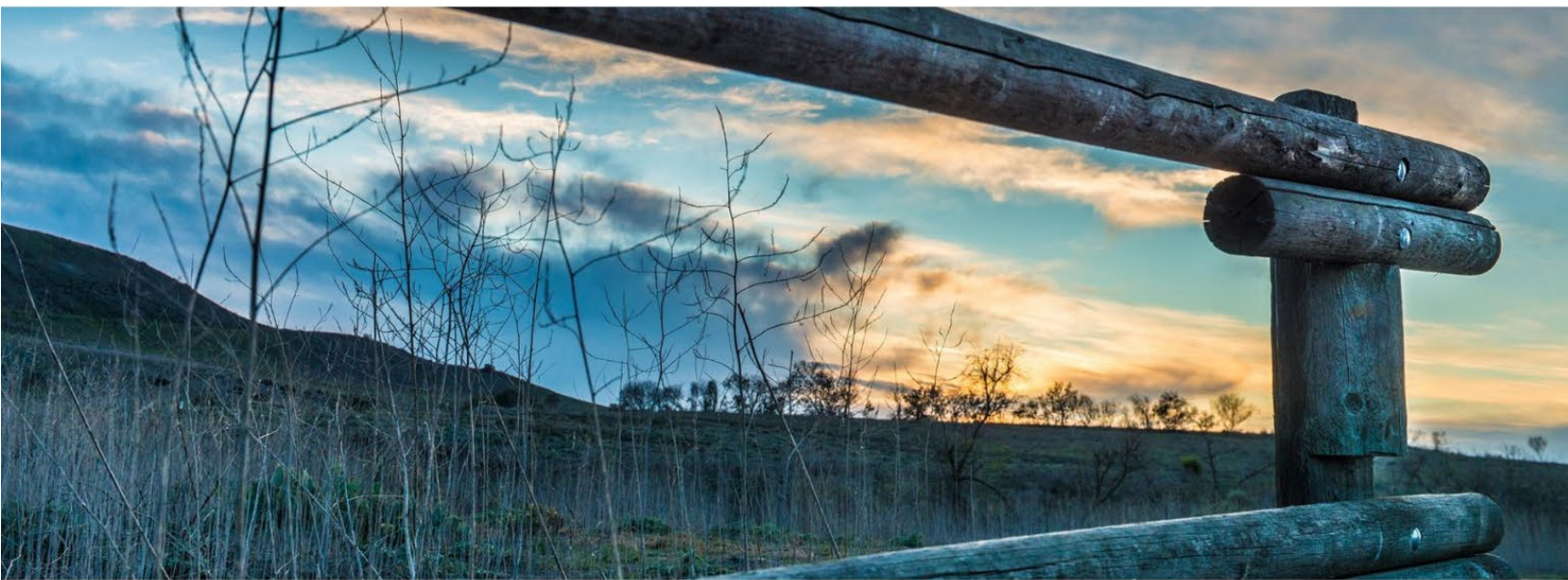

California Residential Mitigation Program

The California Residential Mitigation program has extended the deadline for its Earthquake Brace + Bolt grant program to Friday, October 17. This registration expands eligibility to include non-primary residential properties, giving landlords and other property owners the opportunity to apply for seismic retrofit grants to strengthen wood-framed homes built before 1980 with raised foundations against earthquake damage.
