## Alipaz Street Repavement & Beautification Project

The street repavement portion of the Alipaz Street Repavement and Beautification Project is now complete. Installation of traffic loop sensors at the intersections of Del Obispo Street and Via Positiva, along with new pavement striping and markings, was finished this week. Installation of new irrigation systems and landscaping for the newly constructed median islands is scheduled to take place within the next few weeks. In addition, the City's contractor has begun reconstruction of the sidewalk on Camino Del Avion between Alipaz Street and Via Positiva, adjacent to the Sports Park and the Ecology Center's newly installed fencing. This work is anticipated to be completed during the week of February 23. During construction, parking on Camino Del Avion near the work areas will be limited. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted accordingly. The City appreciates the community's cooperation and patience as improvements to traffic operations, pedestrian access, and landscaping are completed. 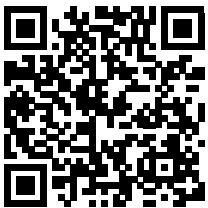

# TAX PREPARATION CHECKLIST

Prepare Your Documents for the Tax Season

## 1. PERSONAL INFORMATION (Required to File)

Bring **all** documents below. **No photocopies accepted.**

- Original picture ID for you and your spouse (if married filing jointly)
- NOTICE: If married filing jointly, both spouses must be present at appointment.
- Taxpayer Identification Number for you, your spouse, and all dependents: Social Security Card, Social Security Number verification letter, or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) assignment letter
- IP PIN (if applicable): IRS Identity Protection PIN notice (CP-01A)

## 2. PROOF OF INCOME

Bring **all** documents that apply

- W-2s for all jobs last year
- 1099s for any other income received last year, including unemployment and self-employment income
- Statements for prizes, scholarships/fellowships, or lottery/gambling winnings

## 3. PROOF OF HEALTH INSURANCE

Bring **all** documents that apply

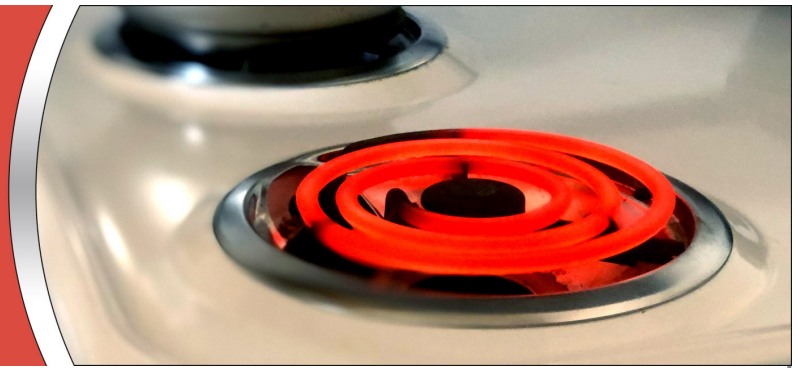
- 1095-A and California Health Insurance Marketplace Statement, if you had coverage through the Marketplace (Covered California)
- 1095-B or 1095-C if you had other kinds of insurance or coverage

## 4. ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Bring **all** documents that apply

- Checking and savings account information to have your refund directly
- Tax return from last year, if available
- Child care expenses: provider's address, phone #, and federal tax ID #
- Homeowners: 1098 mortgage statement and property tax bill
- Education: 1098-T college tuition and 1098-E student loan statements
- Alimony paid or received
- Notices: IRS, Franchise Tax Board (FTB), Health Insurance Marketplace, or anything that says "IMPORTANT TAX DOCUMENT"

# BURN SAFETY



*A burn is damage to the skin caused by heat. Burns and scalds can occur from certain tools, appliances, hot water, or the sun. Every 60 seconds, someone in the United States sustains a burn serious enough to require treatment.*



*In 2018, roughly 70,000 people went to the emergency room because of contact burns. About one-third of these patients were children under the age of 5.*

## Types of Burns

### First Degree (Minor)

- First degree burns usually result in redness and mild pain.

### Second Degree (Moderate)

- Second degree burns are usually bright red with a moist or blistered appearance.

### Third Degree (Severe)

- Third degree burns usually appear charred or ashen and are black or brown in color.
- These burns can result in devastating injury including the loss of function, loss of limbs, disfigurement, reoccurring infection, and sometimes death.

## How to Treat a Burn

- Turn off the heat source and make sure the surroundings are safe.
- Remove clothing and jewelry near a burn, but do not peel off clothing stuck to the burn.
- Run cool water (not cold or icy) on the burn for 5-10 minutes until the pain subsides.
- Apply an antibiotic ointment or dressing to the burn to keep it moist. Do not use creams or greasy substances like butter, toothpaste, or eggs. These can cause infection.
- Call 9-1-1 if you have a burn that affects your mobility or sensation, for any burn larger than your hand, or if the burn affects the feet, face, eyes or genitalia.

## Burn Prevention Tips

- Create a safety zone of at least 3 feet around hot objects or appliances.
- Do not leave hot objects unattended and unplug tools when not in use.
- Keep hot objects away from counter edges and out of the reach of children.
